**ABBREVIATED BOOKING CONDITIONS**

**PAYMENT**

Once you have received your confirmation of booking, the balance of payment due must be sent to us two months prior to departure. If a booking is made within two months of departure, full payment must be made on receipt by the party leader of the confirmation invoice. This date is shown on the confirmation invoice. Reminders are not sent. If we do not receive all payments due (including any surcharge where applicable) in full and on time, we are entitled to assume that you wish to cancel your booking. In this case, we will be entitled to keep all deposits paid or due at that date. If we do not cancel straight away because you have promised to make payment, you must pay the cancellation charges shown under "Cancellation By You" below depending on the date we reasonably treat your booking as cancelled.

**SPECIAL REQUESTS AND MEDICAL CONDITIONS / DISABILITIES**

If you have any special request, you must advise us at the time of booking. Although we will endeavour to pass any reasonable requests on to the relevant supplier, we regret we cannot guarantee any request will be met. Failure to meet any special request will not be a breach of contract on our part.

If you have any medical condition or disability which may affect your tour or have any special requirements as a result of any medical condition or disability (including any which affect the booking process), please tell us before you confirm your booking so that we can assist you in considering the suitability of the arrangements and/or making the booking. In any event, you must give us full details in writing at the time of booking and whenever any change in the condition or disability occurs. You must also promptly advise us if any medical condition or disability which may affect your tour develops after your booking has been confirmed.

**FINANCIAL SECURITY**

We hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence issued by the Civil Aviation Authority (ATOL number 1220). When you buy an ATOL protected air inclusive holiday or flights\* from us you will receive a confirmation invoice from us or via our authorised agent confirming your arrangements and your protection under our ATOL. In the unlikely event of our insolvency the CAA will ensure that you are not left stranded abroad and will arrange to refund any money you have paid to us for an advance booking. Please note: Not all holiday or travel services offered and sold by us will be protected by the ATOL scheme.

\*The air inclusive holidays and flights we arrange are ATOL protected providing either the person who pays for the booking is present in the UK when the booking is made or the first leg of any flight(s) we arrange for you commences in the UK.

**CANCELLATION BY YOU**

A cancellation by you will take effect on the date we receive this in writing. Cancellation of the whole booking requires notification by the party leader. We will apply the following scale of cancellation charges based on the period before departure notice in writing is received and where applicable, is expressed as a percentage of the total tour cost excluding any insurance premiums and amendment charges which are non refundable in the event of cancellation.

2 Age is 95 years or less and is a permanent resident of the United Kingdom.

**POLICY EXCESSES:**

**Cancellation or Curtailment**

The first £50 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded, increased to £100 where You are aged 66 to 75 years and to £150 where You are aged 76 to 95 years (other than in respect of claims for loss of deposit where the excess is £25).

**Medical and Other Expenses**

The first £50 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded.

Where You are aged 66 to 75 years the first £100 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded.

Where You are aged 76 to 95 years the first £200 of each and every claim per Insured Person claimed for under this Section is excluded.

No excess will apply where an EHIC is used to pay medical bills

**Other Sections**

An excess of £50 applies to each and every claim each insured person under the Personal Luggage Money & Valuables sections, and £250 under the Personal Liability section.

**SPECIAL PROVISION FOR SICK PILGRIMS TRAVELLING TO LOURDES**

If You suffer from a terminal illness or any psychiatric illness, special provision is made to provide limited cover as follows.

- a. Under Section 3 Medical & Other Expenses, cover will be provided to You subject to You
  - i. Having obtained and supplied to Us Your EHIC details prior to departure.
  - ii. Having obtained and supplied to Us prior to departure written confirmation of fitness to undertake the intended journey having due consideration for Your state of health, means of transportation and duration of journey from Your regular registered Medical Practitioner.
  - iii. For Terminal Illness, having obtained prior to departure and supplied to Us written confirmation of a prognosis greater than 28 days on the intended date of return to the UK.
- b. A limit of £5,000 shall apply in respect of any Repatriation Expenses.
- c. The Hospital Benefit section of the policy is inoperative.
- d. The Cancellation & Curtailment section is inoperative.

The Policy Excess applying to the Medical and Other Expenses sections is increased to £1,500 or £500 where an EHIC is utilised

You will also need to obtain confirmation from your GP of your fitness to travel.

**EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE:**

There is a 24-hour emergency assistance service included in the policy so that any insured person may seek assistance in medical emergencies whilst on holiday. Full details are contained in the policy document.

**MAIN HEALTH EXCLUSIONS:**

We will not pay for claims arising directly or indirectly from the following circumstances existing on the date of applying for this insurance:

- (a) From any terminal illness suffered by You (or any person upon whose health the Trip depends). See Special Provision for Sick Pilgrims above
- (b) From any reoccurrence of any psychiatric disorder, anxiety state and/or depression suffered by You (or any person upon whose health the Trip depends)

- (c) Where You are travelling against the advice of a Medical Practitioner.

**Cancellation Rights**

The Insurer provides a Money Back Guarantee enabling you to cancel the insurance within 14 days of issue should the policy not meet your requirements. No refund of premium is provided for cancellations after this time.

## Travel Arrangements

### By Air

#### 6 nights in Lourdes.

Departing Sunday 24th July flying direct to Lourdes and return on Saturday 30th July.

All flights are from London Stansted Airport. The price includes taxes and transfers from Lourdes Airport to and from your hotels. Pilgrims staying in the Accueil St Frai will be required to fly from Stansted with the medical team.

### By Coach

#### 5 Nights in Lourdes.

Departing Saturday 23rd July and return to the UK on Saturday 30th July. An overnight journey by luxury air-conditioned coach. Departing from Westminster Cathedral at 10.30am on the Saturday morning, arriving in Lourdes at 9am on Sunday. Return journey departs Lourdes at 7.30pm on the Friday, arriving London Victoria at 3pm on Saturday 30th July.

### By Train (the most economical and "green" way to travel)

#### 6 Nights in Lourdes.

Departing Sunday 24th July and return on Saturday 30th July. Travel by Eurostar from St Pancras to Paris Gare du Nord, then by train to Lourdes station. Coach transfer to your hotel. On the return you will depart mid morning to Paris and onwards to London.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Passports

All pilgrims must possess a full 10 year passport. Please allow at least 8 weeks to obtain yours. Forms are obtainable from the Post Office. Please make sure that your passport is valid up to three months after the return date of the Pilgrimage.

N.B. Children of all ages including babies cannot now be added to parents' passports. They must have their own. No passport = no go and no refund. All holders of non EC passports should make their own enquiries with the French Consulate to find out whether a visa for France is necessary.

### Medical Treatment

Whilst abroad in EC countries medical treatment is covered by a reciprocal agreement with those countries. If you do not yet have a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC), please contact your local Post Office who will give you the necessary forms to complete so that you can have one of these cards, which have replaced the old E111. ## Sick pilgrims and helpers information

### The Sick and those requiring assistance

This pilgrimage is especially for those who are debilitated by illness or frailty. The Westminster Diocese wishes to provide care and assistance to help these individuals enjoy the experience of Lourdes. To do this the Pilgrimage Director asks that pilgrims requiring medical, nursing or carer assistance complete and return a medical form as directed.

**Wheelchairs:** The pilgrimage can provide wheelchairs at Stansted and in Lourdes, and has Helpers available for anyone requiring assistance. All personal wheelchairs taken must be pre-booked as we are limited to the number of wheelchairs we can carry on the various methods of travel. To assist with planning, please request a wheelchair at the time of booking.

**Hotel Facilities:** Most hotels have rooms to cater for special needs such as mobility problems and wheelchair access; however, the booking form indicates which hotels offer the most suitable facilities.

**The Accueil St Frai:** The Accueil St Frai accommodation provides 24hr nursing care and medical assistance. The St Frai does not have private rooms, but the accommodation is modern, well designed, comfortable and has good nurse-led facilities. It is in easy distance of the Grotto within the Sanctuary. **Helpers:** The pilgrimage needs volunteers to help provide assistance for fellow Pilgrims. You can offer to help in one of the roles outlined below. Please do volunteer.

**Red Caps:** Young adults who are 16 or over can offer their services to work as Red Caps for the pilgrimage. The Red Caps work with the sick, the frail and pilgrims requiring special assistance, collectively known as Malades. Pushing wheelchairs, helping with shopping, assisting with travel, carrying bags and acting as interpreters are all part of the daily duties. **St Frai helper:** St Frai helpers work in the Accueil St Frai, assisting the nurses with the care of pilgrims, helping with washing and at mealtimes, and caring for and serving those who, without them, would be unable to take part in the pilgrimage. **Training:** All volunteer helpers will be expected to attend an induction day prior to the pilgrimage. Details of the date, venue and induction schedule will be circulated in May 2010.

**CRB:** It is a requirement, in accordance with the policy relating to the protection of Children and Vulnerable adults, that CRB clearance will be required for all volunteers over the age of 18.

All hotels have lifts, are accessible by wheelchair users and are within walking distance of the Domain along a flat route. All rooms have private facilities and serve three meals a day included in the price.

Requirements for vegetarians and medical diets must be advised by completing the relevant sections on the Booking Form.

### Hotels

All the hotels listed are suitable for wheelchairs and most provide disabled rooms. All are good quality and have been used by us for many years.

Some hotels are suitable for sick pilgrims, contact us to ensure that appropriate medical supervision can be provided during the pilgrimage.

**Beau Site:** An excellent 3 star hotel on the flat, overlooking the river. Lifts to all floors, multilingual staff and a personal service. Wifi.

**Notre Dame de France:** Well established older hotel with most modern amenities. Quite close to the Domain.

**Mediterranée:** Modern hotel with rooms suitable for the less able pilgrim. Air conditioned dining room, plentiful cuisine, large bar and meeting room situated by the river. Wifi.

**The Padoue:** Newly opened in June 2007 and designed for the 21st century this hotel is one of the closest hotels to the Sanctuary. With air-conditioning throughout the Padoue is fully equipped with all modern aids for wheelchair users and the disabled. Wifi.

**Solitude / St Sauveur:** The Solitude is a purpose built hotel situated in a quiet passage, great rooms especially for less able pilgrims, some with good views. The St Sauveur has smaller rooms but a more personal service. The position of both these hotels dictates the price.
